### ADA EQUAL ACCESS GRANT

The 2018 Washington State Legislature appropriated \$1 million in capital funding for ADA Access Grants ([SSB6090 Section 5001](#)). These Grants are solely for facility repairs and alterations at K-12 public schools, including skill centers, to improve compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act and Individuals with Disabilities Education Act.

Districts are limited to one grant not to exceed \$100,000 per three year period and prioritization will be based on limited school district financial resources for the project.

The ADA Equal Access Grant application will be accessible through iGrants Form Package 815 on July 12, 2018 and will close on September 11, 2018 at 4:00 P.M.
