PURPOSE/BACKGROUND

The U.S. Department of Education, under the Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA), requires annual graduation rate reporting using the adjusted cohort method.

The Comprehensive Education Data and Research System (CEDARS) will be the source for the Adjusted 4-year Class of 2018, Adjusted 5-Year Class of 2017, Adjusted 6-Year Class of 2016, and the Adjusted 7-Year Class of 2015 Cohort Graduation Rate Report (P210).

DETAILS

The adjusted cohort graduation (P210) data is reviewed within the 2017–18 Adjusted Cohort Graduation (P210) Application, accessed via the secure Educational Data System (EDS). The application is currently open and the data for each district can be accessed and reviewed. The Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction (OSPI) has populated all sections of the application with data submitted to CEDARS.

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ACTION NEEDED

Districts must review, for each of their schools, the pre-populated data within the Adjusted Cohort Graduation application.

A user guide, located within the Adjusted Cohort Graduation (P210) application, provides instructions on reviewing and updating the annual Adjusted Cohort Graduation (P210) report data.

The Adjusted Cohort Graduation (P210) system will be updated nightly with the most recent CEDARS enrollment information until it closes on October 24.

The deadline for finalizing your data is **October 24**.
