INTRODUCTION

RCW 28A.175.010 requires school districts to account for the educational progress of each of its students in Grades 9–12. The legislative reporting requirement made it necessary for the Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction (OSPI) to collect a record with several data elements for every student in Grades 9–12.

The reporting period is defined as the first day of school in the fall of 1998 to the day before the first day of school in the fall of 1999.

DEFINITIONS:

DROPOUT:

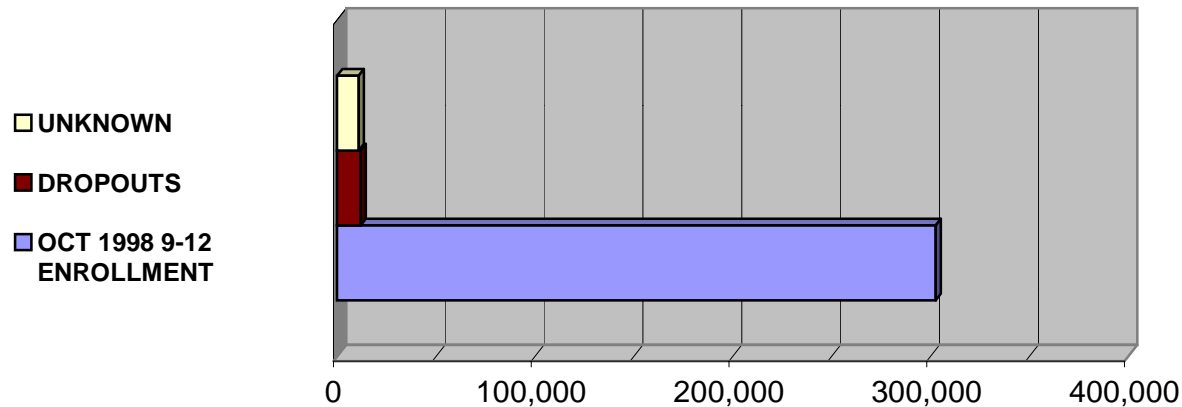
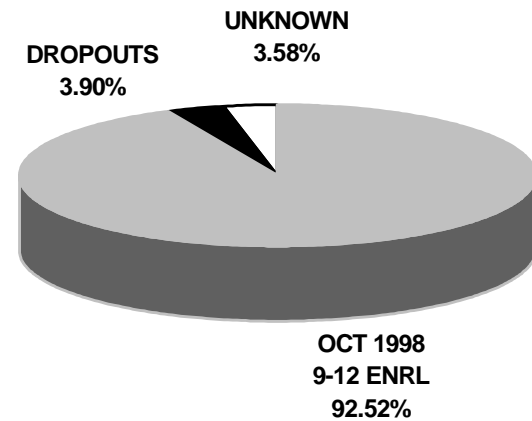
“... A dropout is defined as a student who leaves school for any reason, except death, before graduation or completion of a program of studies and does not transfer to another school. An individual is a dropout whether dropping out occurs during or between regular school terms. A student who leaves during the year, but returns during the reporting period (including summer program) is not a dropout.”

STATUS UNKNOWN:

“... If a student leaves the district, does not indicate he or she is dropping out, and the district is not contacted by another school requesting student records (unconfirmed transfer), the student’s enrollment status is reported as unknown.”
