Note to potential respondents:

This Amendment is intended to revise, clarify and become part of RFQ No. 2018-28, issued May 2, 2018.

All amendments, addendums, and notifications will be posted on the [OSPI website](#) (if this was an open procurement) and released via the Washington Electronic Business Solution ([WEBS](#)) website.

This amendment removes the requirement that companies/firms must reside in Washington State.

Section A.5. BIDDER QUALIFICATIONS shall be amended to read as follows:

~~This RFQ is open to individuals or companies/firms who reside in Washington State. However, historically a role similar to the Continuous Improvement Partners have been individual consultants operating as sole proprietors. If you feel your company meets the minimum qualifications and can fulfill the needs of the RFQ, you are welcome to apply. Historically, a role similar to the Continuous Improvement Partners had been filled by individual consultants operating as sole proprietors; however, if you feel your company meets the minimum qualifications and can fulfill the needs of the RFQ, you are welcome to apply.~~ The project team structure should be clearly outlined with an organizational chart of your firm indicating lines of authority for personnel involved in performance of this potential contract.

All other minimum and desirable qualifications remain the same.

All communications concerning this RFQ must be directed only to the RFQ Coordinator at contracts@k12.wa.us. Any other communication will be considered unofficial and non-binding on OSPI. Consultants are to rely on written statements issued by the RFQ Coordinator. Communication directed to parties other than the RFQ Coordinator may result in disqualification of the Consultant.
